The Landowner wishes to establish a "NO SPRAY ZONE" within the Municipal right-of-way bordering the property described as:

(Additional land descriptions as necessary to be attached to this agreement)

The landowner accepts all responsibility for weed control within the municipal right-of ways bordered by the land described above. Weeds to be controlled or destroyed are on Lethbridge County's prohibited noxious and noxious weed list. The control and destruction of weeds must be carried out to the satisfaction of the **Alberta Weed Control Act. These areas will be inspected throughout the growing season.**

Lethbridge County reserves the right to take whatever measures may be necessary, including the use of chemicals, to control weeds within this zone if the landowner does not fulfill their responsibility for timely, effective control of weeds within the no spray zone.

The landowner will place signs provided by the Lethbridge County nearest to each corner of the land described as a "No Spray Zone" in such a manner as can be easily read, will not pose a hazard to traffic, or will not hamper in any way Municipal access to the right-of-way.

Although Lethbridge County will make every effort to observe and respect the "No Spray Zone", they will in no way, accept responsibility for a planned or inadvertent application of herbicides for the control of weeds within the said zone.
