Lethbridge County Council passed the 2016 budget during the December 17, 2015 council meeting, details of which are outlined in this newsletter. Last fall, the County was honoured to host a delegation from our new twin county, Anyang County, China. The purpose of the visit was to foster relationships, promote trade, exchange ideas, build goodwill, and create international awareness of Lethbridge County's assets. The delegation included six

representatives from Anyang County, the Town of Tongye, and the City of Anyang, who were in Lethbridge County for two days at the end of October. The Consul General for the Chinese Consulate in Calgary joined us to witness the signing of the Twinning Agreement. In order to give our guests a taste of what Lethbridge County has to offer, we took the delegation on a tour, including stops at Western Tractor, DuPont-Pioneer (Canola), Lethbridge Biogas, and lunch at Broxburn Vegetables and Café. The second day, Economic Development Lethbridge hosted the delegation and stops were made at Lethbridge City Hall, Richardson Oilseed, Lethbridge College, and the University of Lethbridge.
