

Located just 30 minutes east of Lethbridge, AB on Hwy 3, Stafford Park's unbeatable location and access to incredible water makes it a haven for sun / sand worshippers and water enthusiasts. It is a popular recreational area that can accommodate an array of activities including watercraft sports, swimming, fishing, basketball, volleyball, horse shoes, bicycle riding, kayak & paddle boarding. A new boat launch and docking area make access to the water quick and easy. The Café with ice cream and novelties is flanked by a new large sandy beach and picnic areas. The Park's seasonal and short-stay non-powered campsites are equipped with fire pits and picnic tables. Quiet generators and/or solar panels are warmly welcomed. Potable water and septic disposal are available by either self-serve or by contracting with the Park for that service. **OPEN: May 1 - October 1, 2018**
