Fire Advisory in Effect for Lethbridge County

LETHBRIDGE COUNTY– Lethbridge County has issued a Fire Advisory due to the dry and warm conditions that exist and are forecasted for the upcoming week. This Fire Advisory is in effect until further notice.

Although this is not a Fire Ban, the County asks citizens to postpone any burning activities until the Fire Advisory has been lifted. If burning is necessary, you must follow the regulations of your Fire Permit and the Fire Permit Bylaw #1424. You are responsible to monitor your fire continuously and extinguish it immediately should winds exceed 15km/per hour.

Do not hesitate to call 911 should at any time your fire become uncontrollable.

If conditions persist, the County may impose a Fire Ban at any time. If a Fire Ban is imposed, you must immediately and fully extinguish your fire.
