WHAT: A treated water reservoir and pump station

WHERE: Hamlet of Monarch

WHY: This project will provide residents with high-quality potable water and a system that can better manage emergency situations and water storage. The truck fill station will also provide convenient access to potable water.



WORK COMPLETED TO DATE

The above ground water tank has been constructed and the truck fill station is currently under construction. The project is nearing completion.

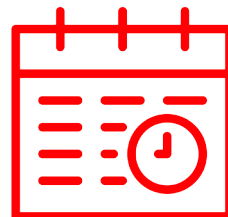
BENEFIT TO RESIDENTS

The reservoir and pump system will not only impact quality of life for residents, but it will also have a significant economic impact on the area.
