

WHAT: A continuation of Malloy Phase 1 between the Town of Coaldale, St. Mary River Irrigation District, and Lethbridge County. Phase 2B includes the redeployment of the abandoned raw water reservoirs in the Town of Coaldale, as well as the construction of a dry pond in the Cottonwood area, which will accommodate an additional 620,000m³ of storm water.

WHERE: Lethbridge County and the Town of Coaldale

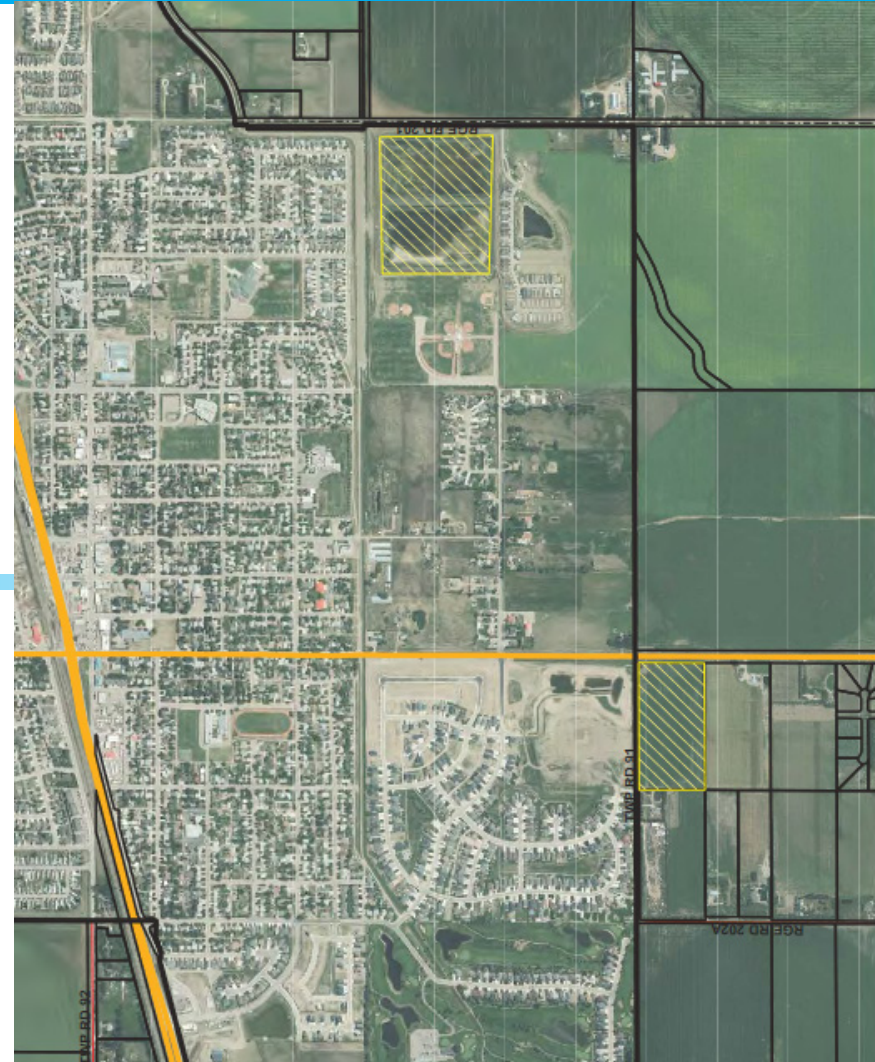
WHY: Providing this infrastructure will benefit residents of Lethbridge County and the Town of Coaldale.

The funding application has been submitted, waiting to hear back.

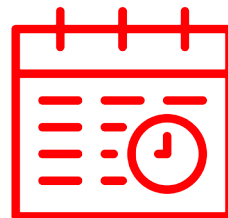
BENEFIT TO RESIDENTS

Providing additional conveyance capacity of storm water in the Malloy Drain will reduce the risk of damage to infrastructure in the future.
