WHAT: Calcium base stabilization of approximately 106 km of roads

WHERE: Identified Haul Routes throughout the County

WHY: The roads identified as Haul Routes are in need of repair. This project will create durable and lower maintenance all-weather roads.



WORK COMPLETED TO DATE

Calcium Chloride Base Stabilization of remaining haul routes was ongoing throughout the summer, with anticipated completion in early November.

BENEFIT TO RESIDENTS

The work done on these haul route roads will reduce maintenance costs once completed, as well as ensure they are safe and reliable for all road users, and that our producers can get their products to market.
