

WHAT: Redesigning the north entrance of the Lethbridge administration building (replacing the existing area with concrete flatwork, a trench drain, and a shed)

WHERE: Lethbridge administration building

WHY: The north entrance of the building has design flaws that are causing issues (the down spout is not connected properly and causes drainage and icing problems in the winter, the paving stone is not properly graded causing water to gather next to the building, and the sidewalk grade does not match the parking lot grade causing a potential liability).



WORK COMPLETED TO DATE

Concrete work is complete. Waiting for the shed to be completed.

BENEFIT TO RESIDENTS

The redesigned entrance will improve safety for staff and citizens entering and exiting the administration building, as well as pedestrians walking through the area.
