Disaster Recovery Program Funding Announced for Lethbridge County

LETHBRIDGE COUNTY– Lethbridge County has been confirmed as one of several municipalities included in the Government of Alberta’s Disaster Recovery Program for the 2018 spring flooding events. The County was approved for \$275,000 in funding to repair infrastructure that was damaged as well as provide reimbursement for contracted costs that were incurred from cleaning out ditches and culverts during the flooding event.

The program also allows eligible citizens to apply for financial assistance for uninsurable property damage and other related expenses that resulted from the flooding. Those wishing to apply should visit aema.alberta.ca/disaster-recovery-programs to download and submit an application form and find the most up-to-date program guidelines. The deadline to apply for this funding is January 2, 2019.
