

# Monarch Reservoir & Pump System

**WHAT:** A treated water reservoir and pump station

**WHERE:** Hamlet of Monarch

**WHY:** This project will provide residents with high-quality potable water and a system that can better manage emergency situations and water storage. The truck fill station will also provide convenient access to potable water.



## WORK COMPLETED TO DATE

The project is substantially complete, minor deficiencies remain.

## BENEFIT TO RESIDENTS

The reservoir and pump system will not only impact quality of life for residents, but it will also have a significant economic impact on the area. The completion of this project will allow existing and future residents to develop properties knowing new infrastructure is in place that can accommodate a growing community. The economic benefits will be long lasting and will serve to enhance and meet future economic demands of the growing community.



### Total project costs: \$2.1 million
