Pursuant to Sections 230, 606 and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of Lethbridge County in the Province of Alberta hereby gives notice of its intention to consider adopting Bylaw 19-011, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 1404, was given First Reading on Thursday, April 4, 2019.

The purpose of the proposed Bylaw 19-011 is to consider the re-designation of the south portion of SE 3-11-23-W4 (as shown on the attached sketch) from Rural Urban Fringe (RUF) to Business Light Industrial (BLI). The proposed Bylaw would allow for the expansion of existing industrial uses on the parcel.

The municipal address of the parcel is 232028 Highway 519 and it is located directly west of the Town of Nobleford.

THEREFORE, TAKE NOTICE THAT A PUBLIC HEARING to contemplate the proposed Bylaw 19-011 will be held in the Lethbridge County Administration Building at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 2, 2019.

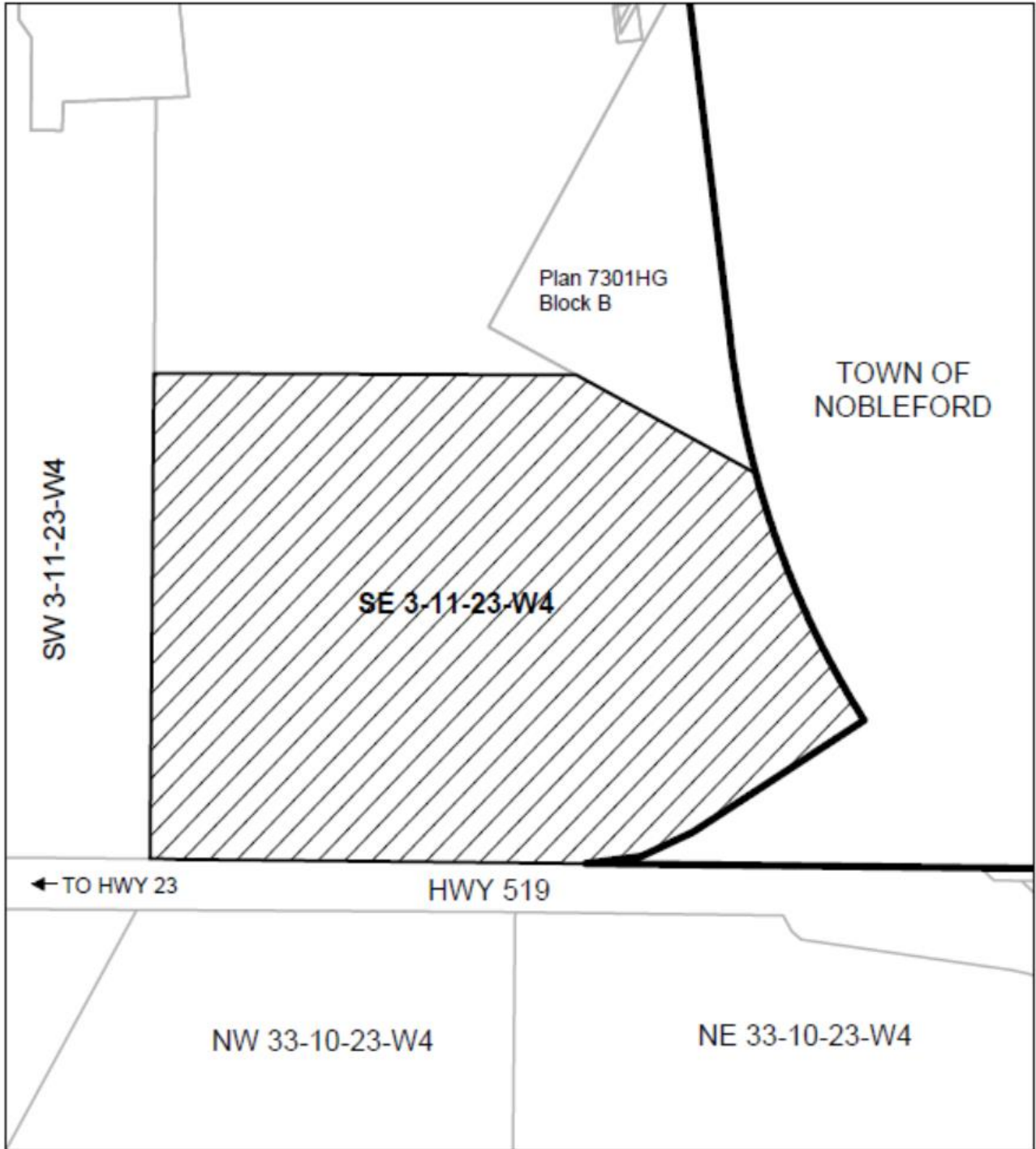
