

2014 Land Trust Reserve Fund Grants

Lethbridge County is pleased to announce that **16 grants** have been awarded from the Land Trust Reserve Fund Grant Program to various local community organizations totaling **\$167,500**.

- **Alberta Birds of Prey Foundation - \$15,000 grant** to renovate aviary facilities, bring in new species and improve recovery time and visitor safety
- **Coaldale Granite Club - \$10,000 grant** for lounge upgrades to flooring and ceiling
- **Friends of Coalhurst Elementary School Society - \$15,000 grant** to construct new playgrounds at Coalhurst Elementary School
- **Hilltopper Gymkhana Club - \$7,500 grant** for kitchen upgrades
- **Indian Hill Golf Course - \$10,000 grant** for new mowers
- **Keho Park Recreation Society - \$10,000 grant** for a new septic field and washroom replacement
- **Nobleford Parent Association - \$15,000 grant** to construct a new playground at Noble Central School
