

# Missed Deadline?

In the event that extra product is available, it will be offered to landowners missing the deadline on a first come, first serve basis at **FULL PRICE for the next 15 business days or until the product is sold out**, whichever comes first.

**NO REFUNDS** will be issued in the event that the dust control application is deferred due to road construction, delay in delivery of product, weather conditions, equipment breakdowns or any other circumstance that may postpone application.

# Dust Control

The Lethbridge County is offering Dust Control for County residents. The program covers products which include chlorides and lignosulfonates and does not include cold mix oil based products or hot mix paving products.

**The County shall attempt to initiate dust control activities in the first 2 weeks of June of each calendar year with due consideration given to weather, road conditions and supply of material. If circumstances dictate that the Dust control crew cannot lay out full amount of material in one day they will be back as soon as practicable to complete application.**

The APPLICANT is required to enter into an agreement with the COUNTY prior to any application of dust control. Payment of full amount shall be required by the APPLICANT prior to commencement of work.

This dust suppression program is a 50:50 cost sharing initiative between the COUNTY and the APPLICANT. The APPLICANT is required to pay **\$5.00** per lineal meter. The dust suppression section shall be set at a minimum length of:

- 50 lineal meters for landowners in subdivisions that do not have more than 50 meters in front of their property or at the discretion of the Public Works department.
- 100 meters to all other landowners.

to a maximum length of 200 lineal meters, with increments of 50 lineal meters. **Any**

**amount in excess of 200 lineal meters shall be charged at full cost to the APPLICANT(s) at \$10.00 per lineal meter.**

Should a landowner want to extend an existing farm oiling, they will be required to apply no less than 100 lineal meters of product on one side or 50 lineal meters on each end of the oiling.



## Application

Applications for Dust Control can be made at the County Administration Office in Lethbridge or at the Picture Butte Shop.

**The deadline for acceptance of applications will be April 1, 2020**

Application forms are available at each office or can be accessed from our website.

**County crews will initiate the application of dust control activities within the first two weeks in June with due consideration given to weather, road conditions and supply of material.**

Once completed, you can drop off your application with full payment at our Lethbridge Office or Picture Butte location. Our staff will provide you with two ribbons.

If you do not have a dust control sign, secure these ribbons on your fence line indicating where you will want the dust control to begin and end. Permanent signage will be installed along your fence line that cannot be removed without permission from the Lethbridge County, Public Works department. If you do have dust control signs put up (such as the picture below), secure the ribbon on the signs. The dust control crew will place your 2020 sticker on your sign for you.

**The ribbons should be securely placed on the fence or the dust control sign no later**



**than April 5, 2020 in a visible location.**

*In consideration of weather conditions, traffic and road structure, there shall be no warranty period with respect to the performance or duration of the dust control.*

***The driveability and safety of the road is the County's top priority and the dust suppression area will be reverted back to its graveled surface when deemed necessary by the graderman or his supervisor.***
