The purpose of this policy is to define how and when Soil Conservation Notices will be issued.

1. Notices will be issued at the discretion of the Supervisor of Ag Services or his designate under the provisions as outlined under the current Provincial Soil Conservation Act, and a copy of Policy 615 will be attached to the notice.
2. When a notice is issued and compliance is lacking, remedial work will be carried out either by County Crews or a Contractor and the charges will be applied against the landowner. The fees are in accordance with the Schedule of Fees By-Law.
3. Where payment is not received for remedial work, including work performed under Policy 615, the amount shall be placed on the taxroll as an additional tax against the land concerned.
4. Where a notice is issued and in the judgement of the Supervisor of Ag Services prosecution in a Court of Law appears to be the only alternative, the matter shall first be reviewed by the Agricultural Service Committee before legal action is initiated.
