The purpose of this policy is to control emergencies and supply the needed information and materials.

The County will maintain a comprehensive program of emergency preparedness to safeguard losses of human and material resources.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Administration is responsible for the complete operation of the program.

The foremen are responsible for controlling emergency equipment and operations for and/or during emergencies.

Workers are responsible for participating in and contributing to the safe emergency operations. Each person is responsible for notifying his/her foreman if equipment is needed, missing or out of order.
