A hazard at the worksite is of prime concern to the management of this County. Therefore, it is the policy of this County to make from time to time, a Hazard Assessment, as hazard assessment must be performed at least once a year.

The Hazard Assessment is to evaluate and control the hazards which exist (or be potential) and that Management make corrections, and control the hazard through:

- a. policies, procedures, and training.
- b. engineering controls.
- c. personal protective equipment.

To identify, eliminate the hazard, and protect the worker from injury.
