The purpose of this policy is to make sure that all required employees are properly trained by Lethbridge County as set forth in the Alberta Municipal Health and Safety Association Flagperson Training Workbook to ensure the safety of the employees and the public.

Lethbridge County will make available all equipment and training time needed to properly train employees for flagging as set forth and taught by Lethbridge County according to the Alberta Municipal Health and Safety Association Flagperson Training Workbook.

The exception to this is that a Flagperson shall remain on the shoulder of the road at all times.
