The purpose of this policy is to insure that all contractors working in Lethbridge County follow the same flagging and safety procedures as Lethbridge County employees.

Before any contractor works on or near any property under the control of Lethbridge County, the contractor must adhere to the safety procedures set forth in the Alberta Construction Safety Association, and the Alberta Municipal Health and Safety Association Flagperson Handbook.

The contractor must also provide proof to Lethbridge County that the Flagperson that he has working for him have been trained from the Alberta Construction Safety Association Flagperson Training Manual. These flagpersons shall also be certified by the Alberta Construction Safety Association.

The exception to this workbook is that a Flagperson shall remain on the shoulder of the road at all times.
