SUBJECT: Transportation of
Dangerous Goods

The purpose of this policy is to confirm the County's commitment to the safe handling, offering for transport and transportation of dangerous goods.

The County shall ensure that when dangerous goods are handled, offered for transport or transported, it shall be in compliance with applicable federal and provincial legislation.

The County shall ensure that all reasonable efforts are taken to ensure both public and employee safety when handling, offering for transport or transporting dangerous goods.

The County shall ensure that only employees with a valid Certificate of Training or employees working under the direct supervision of a person with a valid Certificate of Training shall handle, offer for transport or transport dangerous goods.

CERTIFICATION:

The County shall issue Certificates of Training on behalf of the department and shall maintain all necessary records in accordance with legislated requirements.

Certificates issued by the County shall be valid for a period of 24 months.
