Questions used to examine any rule established.

1. Is there a genuine need for a rule in this area?
2. Does the proposed rule meet this need?
3. Is the rule practical?
4. Can and will the rule be consistently enforced?

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1. Employees must use or wear the protective equipment that is required for the safe completion of the work.
2. Perform all work in accordance with safe work practices.
3. Report to your supervisor or designate all unsafe acts, unsafe conditions and near miss incidents.
4. Report all injury or damage accidents immediately.
5. Maintain good housekeeping in the work area at all times.
6. Operate all equipment in a safe and courteous manner and in accordance with highway regulations.
7. It is prohibited to be in possession of or under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs while on duty.
8. It is prohibited to be in the possession of firearms at the workplace unless authorized by your supervisor.
9. Fighting is prohibited.
10. Theft and vandalism is prohibited.



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11. Damaging, disabling, or interfering with safety, fire fighting, or first aid equipment is prohibited.
12. First aid treatment is to be obtained promptly for any injury.

ALL EMPLOYEES MUST OBEY ALL SAFETY RULES AND SAFETY REGULATIONS. VIOLATIONS WILL BE DEALT WITH PROMPTLY AND CONSISTENTLY.
