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Requests from non-hamlet residents for approval to connect to hamlet water and/or sewage systems will be governed by the contents of this policy.

1. Requests for Connection to Hamlet System:
  - to be approved by the County of Lethbridge and the Hamlet Water User's Co-op.
2. Hook-up Fee
  - Non-resident contribution \$1500.00 hook-up fee.(Contribution to go to the Water User's Co-op)
3. Water Rate:
  - current monthly water rate.
4. Water Use:
  - Water is to be used for household use only.
5. Installation Costs:
  - Installation shall be at no cost to the County of Lethbridge, or the Iron Springs Water User's Co-op.
6. Type of Material:
  - Material used for water supply to be of a type approved by the Water and Sewer Supervisor. e.g. (4" and larger C900 PVC pipe, 3/4" to 2" pipe 160 PSI poly pipe or poly B municipal water service pipes).
7. Method of Installation
  - Water lines to be installed in a method approved by the Water and Sewer Supervisor and before backfill the installation is to be inspected by the Supervisor.
8. Metering Device
  - Remote read-out and approved and regularly maintained backflow preventer.
9. Utility Right of Way
  - shall be the responsibility of the person applying for the water connection
10. Right to Enter
  - County and the Iron Springs Water Co-op has the right to enter property to check installation and water meter regularly.
11. Maintenance
  - the water user shall be responsible for maintenance of water line on their property.
