

Council Brief of the August 3, 2023 Regular Meeting This document is provided for informational purposes only and is not the approved minutes of the Lethbridge County Council meeting.

DELEGATIONS:

1) Bursary Recipients

Council presented a \$1,500 bursary each to Abigail Giacchetta, Emma Reurink, and Elayna Vucurevich for their post-secondary studies.

PUBLIC HEARINGS:

1) Bylaw 23-019 - Road Closure, Sale and Consolidation- Public Hearing

Council approved that the road closure be sent to the Alberta Minister of Transportation for approval. The closure is for a portion of Township Road 10-0 east of Range Road 23-3. It has been determined that this road is no longer required as part of the County's road network.

SUBDIVISION APPLICATIONS

1) Application #2023-0-075 – Bezooyen - NE1/4 32-08-19-W4M

Council approved the supplication subject to the conditions outlined in the draft resolution. The application is to application is to split a title of 18.6 acres into two titles for country residential use.

2) Subdivision Application #2023-0-083 – Androkovich - NW1/4 30-08-20-W4M

Council approved the supplication subject to the conditions outlined in the draft resolution. The application is to subdivide a 5.74-acre first parcel out subdivision from a title of 158.86 acres for country residential use.

3) Subdivision Application #2023-0-085 – Van Hierden - Block Z, Plan 6150Y within SW1/4 07-10-23-W4M (Hamlet of Monarch)

Council approved the supplication subject to the conditions outlined in the draft resolution. The application is to subdivide 0.07 acres from a title comprised of 0.65 acres for private utility use.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

1) COMMUNITY SERVICES

a. Joint Use and Planning Agreements - Palliser School Division and Westwind School Division Agreements

Council approved the agreements with both school divisions, which are intended to enable the integrated and long-term planning and use of school sites on municipal reserve, school reserve, and municipal school reserve land. The Province has required that every municipality have a joint use and planning agreement with any school division within its municipal boundary.

b. Planning and Development Department - 2nd Quarter Report 2023

The Supervisor of Planning and Development provided an update on activities in the second quarter of 2023, including:

- Held a Land Use Bylaw review workshop with Council
- Partnered with the Town of Taber on the Rural Renewal Stream (Alberta Advantage Immigration Program)

- Commenced transfer of land process for Riverbrink subdivision pond to the Riverbrink Water Users Co-op Ltd.
- Between January 1 June 30:
 - \circ 136 development permit applications received (increase from 111 in 2022)
 - o 8 Land Use Bylaw complaints received and investigated
 - o 387 building/safety codes permits issued
 - o 18 subdivision applications approved by Council

c. April - June 2023 Community Peace Officer Report

The Community Peace Officer provided an update on activities in the second quarter of 2023, including:

- 70 case reports created (34 Highway Protection Bylaw, 13 Dog Control Bylaw, 7 Traffic complaints, 11 commercial vehicle inspections with a 72% failure rate)
- Numerous violations regarding pivot end guns watering roads
