Reeve Campbell called a recess to the Council Meeting, for the Public Hearing for Bylaw 23-002 and Bylaw 23-003 at 10:00 A.M.

Ray Martin of Martin Geomatics spoke in favour of the proposed bylaws on behalf of the applicant Jody Nakamura.

Jody Nakamura and Scott Sterr - applicants - spoke in favour of the bylaws due to the land not being agriculturally viable.

Warren Salberg spoke against the proposed bylaws for the following reasons: potable water, light industrial zoning setbacks, viable agriculture land, noise concerns, Range Road 20-5 concerns, water supply and table concerns, and drainage issues.

Conrad Walburger spoke in favour of the proposed bylaws as it keeps traffic close to Lethbridge.

Mark Heninger spoke against the proposed bylaws due to the proposed parcel size of the development and Range Road 20-5 concerns.

Floyd Joss spoke in favour of the proposed bylaw because the land is not viable farmland.

Kelsey Nadeau spoke against the proposed bylaws due to concerns about septic collection concerns.

Anita Salberg spoke against the proposed bylaws due to concerns about dust, noise, traffic increases, and privacy.

Rick Kille spoke against the proposed bylaws due to concerns about quality of life and the size of the development.

Ed Martin of Martin Geomatics spoke in favour of the proposed bylaws and noted that SMRID will be upgrading the water supply line to the area.

Moira Warnock spoke against the proposed bylaws with concerns about dust, noise, and quality of life.

Susan Whishaw spoke against the proposed bylaws.

Deb Richter spoke against the proposed bylaws with concerns about road usage and quality of life.

Lyndon Nakamura spoke in favour of the proposed bylaw due to the land not being viable agriculture land.

Reeve Campbell asked for any further comments in favour or opposition to the bylaws. No further comments were made.
